

Healthcare Financial Management

Teaching experience in healthcare managerial accounting and in healthcare financial management preferred.

All applicants must satisfy the following requirements to be considered for the position:

Tenure track: At the assistant-professor level the department requires potential for excellence in teaching and research, and ability to secure independent funding.

Tenure: At the associate-professor level the department requires a strong teaching, research, and publication record in addition to the ability to secure independent funding.

All applicants are required to submit a cover letter, curriculum vitae, list of references, two publications, personal statement, statement of teaching philosophy, and statement of research.
