NC State University Staff Course Registration

Did you know that as a full-time NC State University staff member you can take up to two courses a year for free?

Registering for a course, as a staff member, is a three-step process.

1. The first step is to become eligible to register as a Lifelong Education Student. For more information, visit the Credit Programs & Summer Sessions webpage in regards to eligibility: http://www.ncsu.edu/cpss/registration/index.html. Once you have determined your eligibility, complete an online application at http://www.ncsu.edu/acp/application.

- 2. The second step is to determine if you are eligible for the tuition waiver program and apply for a waiver. First, review the policy on faculty/staff tuition waivers:

If you determine you are eligible for the faculty/staff tuition waiver, complete the Faculty/Staff Tuition Waiver Form available for download at http://www.ncsu.edu/cpss/forms/tuition_waiver.pdf. Forms should be completed and given to your departmental liaison for proper signature and forwarding to the Cashier's Office.
- 3. The third step is to register for courses. The tuition waiver may be used for both on-campus and distance education courses. Once you have received a confirmation e-mail from Credit Programs & Summer Sessions, which will include your PIN, you will use Pack Tracks to register for courses.
