The College of Management is seeking a faculty member to lead the development of its new MBA concentration in Biotechnology and Pharmaceutical Management. Successful candidates must be able to: (1) lead curriculum development and implementation, (2) engage industry in support of the program, and (3) provide leadership in faculty and student recruitment. The ideal candidate would have a Ph.D. in management, economics, or a technical scientific discipline and have interest and/or a track record of doing research in the biotech/pharma arena. The College is especially interested in applicants who specialize in R&D management, marketing, or technology management. The College of Management is also willing to consider individuals with an advanced degree who have worked in the industry for 10 or more years and would qualify for a professor of practice position.

Essential duties of the position include teaching and developing a network of firms within the industry that would engage with NC State's MBA students and faculty. Candidates must be able to interact and communicate effectively with students, faculty, and the biotech-pharma business community.

Position may be tenure track for applicants with Ph.D. in management discipline or non-tenure track for well-qualified candidates with significant Biotechnology and/or Pharmaceutical Management Industry experience.
