Academic Regalia

The masters and doctoral graduates are wearing the traditional black cap and gown and a colored hood. Of all the components of the academic costume, the hood is most symbolic. The hood's coloring and size represent the level and subject of degree earned, as well as the institution from which it was awarded. The hood has colors on it in two different places. On one side of the hood there are patches of velvet, and on the other side there are large patches of silk. The silk patches are the colors of the institution that gave the degree. The velvet indicates the area of study.

Faculty typically wear the regalia of the institution from which they earned their highest degree.

The graduates wear a cap or "mortar board" with a tassel. The tassels for the PhD degree are gold, and those for other graduate and professional degrees may correspond to the trimmings on the hoods.

The stoles and cords represent a rich variety of honors and associations in which the graduates have participated during their time at North Carolina State University.

Commencement Speaker

Jean Driscoll

Jean Driscoll is a motivational speaker, author, award-winning athlete and advocate worldwide for persons with disabilities. She has also done work as a television sports commentator and currently serves as the executive director of development in NC State University's College of Design.

She earned a bachelor of arts degree in speech communication with honors in 1991 and a master of science degree in rehabilitation administration in 1993, both from the University of Illinois. In 1997, Jean was awarded an honorary doctorate degree from the University of Rhode Island and an honorary law degree from the Massachusetts School of Law in 2002. In April 2012, she received the Lincoln Academy's "Order of Lincoln", the highest honor given by the State of Illinois. Past recipients include Ronald Reagan and Jack Benny.

Jean won the Boston Marathon eight times during her athletic career and was the first person in history to achieve this feat. She held the world's best time in the women's wheelchair division at Boston for 21 years and established new world records five times. Jean also won two Olympic and 12 Paralympic medals as a member of Team USA and still holds the world record in the 10,000 meter track event. *Sports Illustrated for Women* magazine recognized Jean as one of the top 25 female athletes of the twentieth century and in July 2012, she was inducted into the U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame.

Jean has been active as a global advocate for people with disabilities. She traveled to Ghana, West Africa multiple times to teach athletes and coaches about the sport of wheelchair track. Largely due to her efforts, Ghana sent its first two athletes in history to the Paralympic Games in 2004 and continued sending athletes later.

Jean has served as a corporate spokesperson for Ocean Spray, United Airlines, Lighthouse Foods and the California Date Commission. She has also been featured on Good Morning America, the Today Show, ABC Nightline, Lifetime TV, ESPN, CNN, and The Late, Late Show.
